

SERVICE ADDENDUM – AMBULATORY CARE ALERTS

Project Name and Effective Date	Health Information Exchange for Treatment, Payment, and Health Care Operations using facility admission/discharge/transfer data (A/D/T) to notify care providers of patient admission and or discharge to a facility (an Alert). Effective:
Data Submitted for Exchange	Facility A/D/T data including Patient demographic information and ambulatory provider’s patient demographic information (current patient list). Alerts may include patient medical record(s) number, and date of event.
Data Provider(s)	Hospitals (ADT). Ambulatory Providers and Health Plans (Demographics).
Data Recipient(s)	Ambulatory Providers and Health Plans (Alerts)
Query Conditions	Exchange will monitor facility A/D/T and notify (Alert) ambulatory patient provider or health plan. Alerts are based on facility admission or discharge to acute or Emergency Department and concurrent presence on an ambulatory practice current patient list.
Permitted Uses	Health Care Providers and Health Plans (Authorized Users) may access the Exchange to receive alerts from the exchange.
Authorized Users	Authorized Users are employees, independent contractors or agents of a Health Care Provider or Health Plan who (i) have been authenticated and given access in compliance with NCHIIN HIE Policies and Standards by the Participant; (ii) accepts responsibility for compliance with the terms of the Authorized User Agreement, and (iii) require access to Data to facilitate the provision of treatment by the Health Care Provider to Patients.

Definitions for Project Addendum	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. “Treatment” means the provision, coordination or management of health care services by one or more Health Care Providers, as defined by HIPAA Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information, 45 C.F.R. Part 164, Subpart E. 2. “Payment” encompasses the various activities of health care providers to obtain payment or be reimbursed for their services and of a health plan to obtain premiums, to fulfill their coverage responsibilities and provide benefits under the plan, and to obtain or provide reimbursement for the provision of health care Privacy Rule at 45 CFR 164.501. 3. "Health Care Operations" are certain administrative, financial, legal, and quality improvement activities of a covered entity that are necessary to run its business and to support the core functions of treatment and payment. These activities, which are limited to the activities listed in the definition of “health care operations” at 45 CFR 164.501 4. 3. “A/D/T Reports” means information on patient admission,

	discharge, or transfer, relating to those events and generally including the date, time, and a brief description of the reason for the event and/or any updates to the patient demographic information in clinical facilities and ambulatory settings.
